

WCCI Timeline

- June 1970 Randy Smith-Dennis Voy decide to build WCCI
- November 7th 1971 WCCI goes on the air
- Fall of 1976 Carroll County Communications buys WCCI from Carroll County Broadcasting: Ed Bock, Bill Hewig, Tom Campbell & Cindy Scott
- 1978 Ann Murphy joins staff as office manager
- 1981 Dee Zemke joins staff as salesperson
- August 1982 Mark Schoening named news director Beaver Miller joins staff
- June 9, 1984 Beaver Miller & Vickie Albers were married
- May 1984 begins broadcasting in stereo
- November 1984 the board buys out Scott, Beaver becomes stockholder/general manager Ann Murphy named station manager, Dee Miller named sales manager
- 1986 board buys out Hewig & Campbell
- Spring of 1988 new Harris transmitter installed
- Fall of 1990 WCCI erects new 422 ft tower
- November of 1990 WCCI increases power from 3,000 to 25,000 watts begins broadcasting with new state of art computer assisted programming
- 1993 Margaret Bock transfers shares in WCCI to Pam Bock
- Mid 90's Ann Murphy, Dee Miller & Mark Schoening become stockholders
- January 1, 1998 board member Margaret Bock passed away
- July 1999 WCCI upgrades to the latest in digital audio with Scotts Studios
- 2001 WCCI tops the half million dollar mark in raising funds for local groups
- February 2005 Ann Murphy semi retires stays on as comptroller and stockholder Brian Reusch is named station manager
- November 7, 2006 special 35th anniversary broadcast with Beaver Miller, Ed Bock, Ann Murphy, Dennis Bowman & Randy Smith
